Spring semester***

The AUEB Library and Information Center continues to offer training seminars for postgraduate students at the University. **The major prospect is to acquaint all students with the infrastructure, the collections, the digital resources and the Library services, so that they can explore and use them, to familiarize students with the techniques of finding and using scientific and quality information, and to give basic guidelines on how to write a paper or a thesis, to avoid plagiarism, and to reference sources.**

In order to address the changes and challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Library is utilizing the tools for distance learning and is organizing **educational activities with the use of the [MS Teams platform](#).**

In the same way, the Library is providing systematic **online (live) help for the personalized support of every AUEB member**, in terms of remote access and use of digital resources, research material, and guiding.
